Winter Park Veterinary Hospital provides your exotic pet with a "Home Away from Home" in our newly designed All Creatures Inn.

Our Avian room and Small Mammal room are specially designed to make your exotic pet feel right at home. Tucked away in a quiet corner, your exotic pet will be in a climate controlled, comfortable area away from other noisy boarders.

Our exotic boarders are cared for by our well-trained Veterinary Technicians. A daily health record is kept to monitor eating, elimination, weight and any behavior issues while boarding.

BOARDING REQUIREMENTS

All exotic boarders must be current on their annual examinations. All avian boarders except parakeets and cockatiels should be current on their polyoma vaccination. If the necessary vaccinations were not given by Winter Park Veterinary Hospital, a copy of the vaccination record stating the vaccines were given by a licensed veterinarian within the applicable time frame is required.

All exotic boarders must be free from external parasites (fleas, ticks, lice and mites) when admitted for boarding. If any are found, removal of the parasites will be done at the owner's expense by our staff.

In order to ensure the health of your pet, a **Medical Exam** with one of our veterinarians is required for all **FIRST TIME** exotic boarders and yearly after. During this time, you and your pet may meet with a veterinary technician so we can learn more about your pet and their unique needs.

Upon arrival, one of our Technicians will admit your pet for boarding. Any additional services that you would like can be requested at this time. A Guest Registration Form will be filled out with all important information regarding your pet to help ensure a pleasant stay. Emergency contacts and emergency phone numbers are also needed.

If at any time your pet's health becomes a concern to our staff, you have the option to have them treated with or without additional permission.

Any emergency situation will be handled immediately.

If problems are noted, the veterinarian will examine your pet and the appropriate fee will be charged. If the cost of the treatment is estimated to exceed the stated amount, every effort will be made to contact you to obtain permission.

ACCOMMODATIONS

All guests are encouraged to bring their exotic pet's cage, carrier, and/or habitat. Any light and/or heat source and any unique bedding is also recommended to help ensure your pet has a pleasant and relaxing stay. If you do not wish to bring in your pet's cage, one can be provided for your pet.

When making a reservation, be sure to let our staff know if you would like us to provide a cage for your pet.

Along with their cages, we also encourage our guests to bring their pet's regular diet. This is to make sure that your pet is as comfortable as possible and that no sudden change in diet affects their stay. If fresh fruits/veggies are required for feeding and need to be restocked during an extended stay, a "shopping" fee may be incurred.

When bringing any of your pet's belongings, please be sure to properly label them with your pet's name and your last name.

If your pet requires medication to be administered while boarding, an appropriate fee will be charged.
